My son Avery was diagnosed on the autism spectrum at 18 months, and has been going to various therapies for the last 2 years including Birth to 3, sensory and speech therapy. Avery has been attending Time 2 Shine for just over a month now, and the progress I have seen in him is beyond measure. I almost can't name just one area he has improved in, as it seems like he is an entirely new child!

His language has gone from rote phrases to interactive conversations. He's gone from happily sitting in a dirty pull-up to going pee and poop in the potty and wanting to wear big boy underwear! His obsession with letters and numbers is beginning to expand into other interests and he is pretend-playing more. He is interacting with his peers now, where he almost never used to speak to other kids. He is learning how to take turns and is becoming interested in gross motor play. His becoming a more happy confident little boy,

who communicates more and melts down less. His regular daycare is so impressed with his progress that every day they beam when they tell me the new things that he has done.

Paul Graumann and Julie Klusmann are wholly committed to their mission with these children, and it is demonstrated every single day with the progress my son is making. Up to now, I had never met anyone who was as excited to talk about my son as I am! They communicate with me on a regular basis, and let me know things I can do at home to help reinforce what he is learning. The amount of love and guidance they provide to these kids makes me thank God every day that I found this program.
